3.6 full-time sworn officers per 1,000 people (based on a population of 1,872,677).

301 part-time sworn officers with 23 vacant positions.

1,655 full-time civilian employees.

179 part-time civilian employees.

36 vacant positions (both full-time and part-time).

Reserve Officers

47 reserve officers.

13% of the total agencies use reserve officers.
